

ENGLISH LANGUAGE – ELEMENTARY I & II

Overview

These courses will move students from basic comprehensibility to that of an elementary language user. The focus on vocabulary and syntax is intensified at this level in order to aid the student in creating more complex communication for use outside of the classroom.

Learning Objectives

At the completion of the two levels, participants should be able to:

- . Understand short, simple paragraphs about familiar topics using a variety of phonemic, grammatical, and vocabulary strategies
- . Create simple edits of simple sentences using level-appropriate grammar and writing
- . Understand and respond to classroom instructions, personal information, and statements and questions about a number of simple, everyday topics
- . Speak using learned phrases and short sentences about familiar topics in predictable, straightforward situations at the elementary level
- . Accurately use level-appropriate grammar in reading, writing, listening, and speaking

Course Duration:	2-hours/day (1-2 Months)
Course Format:	Instructor-led course
