

ENGLISH LANGUAGE – PRE-ELEMENTARY I & II

Overview

These 2 courses are an extension of the starter course. The aim is to teach strategies that build on existing basic knowledge of English words and grammar in order to advance: reading, writing, speaking, listening, and pronunciation skills. Students learn to understand, pronounce, read and write common vocabulary in simple sentences that reflect real life situations.

Learning Objectives

At the completion of the two levels, participants should be able to:

- . Read & write simple written words and phrases using context, and visual clues
- . Read & write phone numbers, addresses, dates, time, and prices
- . Read & write basic sentences to express opinions for social media use
- . Speak using learned phrases and short sentences about familiar topics in predictable, straightforward situations at the pre-elementary level

Course Level: Pre-Elementary Level 101 and 102

Course Duration: 2-hours/day (1-2 Months)

Course Format: Instructor-led course

Target Audience: This course is open to all those who are interested in learning the English language.
