ENGLISH LANGUAGE - PRE-INTERMEDIATE I & II

Overview

These courses focus on competency. They aim to teach students multiple paragraph communication. Students learn to understand, pronounce, read, and write common vocabulary in simple and more complex sentences that reflect real life situations.

At the completion of the two levels, participants should be able to:

- . Understand short reading passages, 1-2 simple paragraphs, about everyday topics using a variety of phonemic, grammatical, and vocabulary strategies.
- . Write simple sentences using level-appropriate grammar and writing.
- . Appropriately respond to classroom instruction, personal information, statements, and questions about a number of simple, everyday topics.
- . Speak using learned & spontaneous phrases and short sentences about familiar topics in predictable, straightforward situations at the elementary level.
- . Accurately use level-appropriate grammar in reading, writing, listening, & speaking.
